Greenhouse Gas Reporting & Carbon Reduction Goal Setting

>>> Burton constructs greenhouse gas (GHG) and carbon inventory reports for companies ranging from national retailers to local hotel groups for publication in annual reports or other communications.

- An emissions reduction strategy consists of methods to reduce natural gas consumption, facility electrification, and renewable energy opportunities.
- >>> One way of reducing your carbon footprint is preventing carbon emissions from entering the atmosphere in the first place. Burton routinely conducts GHG emissions reduction audits to assess the current state of site facilities and operational practices. This is then integrated into an emissions reduction roadmap, detailing energy efficiency opportunities and electrification potential, layering in renewable energy and alternative fuel sources.
